# \*Transitions - explanation

### Basic Crew Up transitions are transitions that allow smooth connection between video shots. They include:

- **Cut:** Instant change from one shot to another. The most commonly used transition, ideal for dynamic and fast-paced videos.
- **Fade In/Out:** Gradual appearance or disappearance of the image. Used for opening or closing scenes, or for smooth changes between video parts.
- **Zoom In/Out:** The effect of moving closer to or away from the image. Highlights details or changes perspective between shots. Slide: One shot "slides" over another from left, right, up, or down. Gives a sense of rhythm and movement, especially in promotional and energetic videos.

#### **Advanced Crew Up transitions (in addition to basic ones) include:**

- **Glitch:** A video error effect creating a modern, dynamic look. Used for a contemporary and technical aesthetic.
- **Spin (Rotation):** A transition where the shot rotates while switching to another, adding energy and motion.
- **Wipe:** One shot "pushes" another out of the frame, creating a sense of continuity and smooth passage between scenes.

### Premium Crew Up transitions (in addition to basic and advanced ones) include:

- **Iris Round:** The shot opens or closes like a camera lens, creating an elegant, cinematic transition.
- **Split:** The screen divides into multiple parts, showing different shots simultaneously.
- Whip-Pan: A fast camera pan motion left or right between two shots, creating a blurred transition. To use this properly, video materials must be shot with preplanned quick movements.

## \* \* Image and sound correction - explanation

**Basic Crew Up correction** improves the essential elements of sound and image, making the video clearer and more pleasant to watch on mobile devices:

#### Sound:

- Normalization: Adjusting volume to an optimal level for consistent listening.
- Silence trimming: Removing unnecessary quiet parts at the start or end of the video.
- **Balance:** Ensuring even distribution between left and right channels, optimized for mono sound on mobile devices.
- Basic equalization: Light frequency adjustments to make speech and sound clearer.

#### **Image:**

- Brightness and contrast: Adjusting overall brightness and contrast for better visibility.
- Color saturation: Lightly increasing color intensity to make visuals more appealing.
- Sharpness: Improving image clarity, especially useful for mobile footage.
- Cropping: Adapting the video format to vertical display (9:16) for TikTok, Reels, Shorts, and other platforms.

**Advanced Crew Up correction** includes additional adjustments for a more professional look:

#### Sound:

- Dynamic processing: Using compressors to control dialogue and effect volume.
- **Reverb and effects:** Subtle addition of ambient effects to enhance the sound experience.
- Advanced equalization: Precise sound frequency tuning to highlight key tones.
- **Noise reduction:** Removing background noise from recorded material.

#### **Image:**

- Color correction: Adjusting tones and colors for a more appealing look on mobile.
- **Exposure correction:** Adjusting brightness and shadows for better visibility.
- **Vignetting:** Slightly darkening the image edges to draw focus to the center.
- Masking: Precisely adjusting parts of the image to highlight specific elements.

#### Sound:

- Advanced dynamic processing: Multi-stage compression for a perfectly balanced sound mix.
- **Enhanced reverb and special effects:** Use of high-quality reverbs and sound effects to enrich the atmosphere.
- **Detailed equalization:** Precise shaping of all key frequencies.
- Foley and additional sound elements: Adding sound effects (e.g., ambient sounds) to create a more realistic experience.

#### **Image:**

- Advanced color grading: Deep color correction to create a specific mood or atmosphere.
- Selective masking: Adjusting specific image areas to highlight key elements.
- Detail enhancement: Improving image texture for greater clarity and definition.
- **Subtle visual effects:** Using gentle effects to enhance the video without overloading the image.

#### Note:

The final video quality depends on the quality of provided footage. Editing can improve existing elements, but cannot "save" technically poor recordings (e.g., audio with unfixable errors).
